Better Boundaries

A comprehensive therapy program is vital in the treatment of adolescents with sexual behavior problems and has been shown to reduce the risk of re-offending. Our program works with the entire family to break the cycle of sexual abuse.

Our program offers group therapy, individual therapy, and family therapy as well as support groups for parents. Help is offered for children and the family members.

Life Strategies Counseling, Inc. has been extremely effective in changing behaviors and thinking patterns of adolescents with problematic sexual behaviors.



Better Boundaries is a program offered by LSCI that is structured to fit the needs of those who are victims and/or perpetrators of sexual abuse. Better Boundaries provides treatment in a multitude of forms.

For the **child** victim of sexual abuse, we offer individual therapy, family therapy, and case management services conducted by therapists and case managers who are specifically trained to work with the special needs of a child sexual abuse victim.

For the **adolescent** offender, we offer individual and family therapy, case management services, psychosexual assessments, and group therapy conducted by therapists and case managers who have been trained to work with the adolescent offending population. We provide monthly updates to courts and probation departments. We also provide a group where the guardians of the offender can attend to learn more about sexual abuse behavior and how to cope with the struggles of having a child in the home who has offended and/or been offended on.

Psychiatric services with **Medication Management** is also available. Therapy services will be provided both at home and at one of our locations.

Program length can vary based on the court order placed on the offender but most clients will be expected to complete the program within **2 years**.

Services will focus on the environmental and psychological issues that lead to offending as well as other behavioral or mental health issues that the client may be experiencing.
